

Construction Fire Safety Co-ordinators Course

Duration: Three Hours

Designed for: Any employee who is a potential, or appointed, Construction Site Fire Safety Co-ordinator.

Objectives: To enable staff to understand their role with regards fire safety on the construction site. To provide them with a clear understanding of the principles contained within the 'Joint Code of Practice' thus preparing them for their role as the fire safety co-ordinator.
